

About the Essay "No Enemies":

In the essay, the World-Friend Adi Da calls for a new global process, which would, in his words, give "governing force" to the principle of prior unity. How is this to come about? It requires as he says, "an instrument" that would enable global humanity to become self-organized and self-managed. He names this yet-to-be-realized instrument the "Global Cooperative Forum".

The necessity for such a Global Cooperative Forum rests on the fact that no presently-existing global organization is equipped to truly deal with the complexity of the world situation. While global organizations, such as the United Nations, were established after World War II, they have been unable to function effectively for the well-being of the whole because of the prevailing paradigm—which is that of separate parties negotiating settlements that maximize their own self-interests. The global good (both human and non-human) is thereby subordinated to the aims of the separate parts. In the current world, human beings are simply suffering this situation, or exploiting it, or both. Therefore a shift of consciousness is essential, from the mind of separateness and competition to taking responsibility for the whole.

In this essay—and more fully elaborated in his book *Not-Two <u>Is</u> Peace*—Adi Da describes how the Global Cooperative Forum would be the expression of "everybody-all-at-once"—meaning the unique force and potential in humankind when it wakes up and becomes aware of itself as one family, even one "system", existing in unity with (and responsible for) the entire Earth-system.

Do you know the meaning of the artwork on the book cover of Not-Two Is Peace?

The image on the cover is a flag design created by Adi Da specifically for the Global Cooperative Forum. He explains the significance of the flag as follows:

National flags represent the already presumed separateness of national identities. In contrast, the Global Cooperative Forum is represented by a single flag, consisting of a single spectrum of colors on a white field.

The white field is a "tabula rasa" (or blank slate), symbolizing the absence of all the "self"-imagery by which human beings create differences between themselves and others. In addition, the plain white flag is a traditional sign of truce or surrender. The party waving the white flag is signaling that it does not want confrontation, and that is is not posing a threat.

The Global Cooperative Forum is not there to confront anyone. It relinquishes all confrontation and all war, and it upholds no self-imagery beyond the simple reality of being part of the totality of humankind.

The presence of the rainbow straight across the flag indicates that the Global Cooperative Forum is actually functioning as a global institution. The spectrum of color on the white field symbolizes inclusiveness in every sense-- all flags, all races, and all nations.

The 723 in the lower left corner stands for the date July 23, 2006. In his essay entitled "723" (Essay XXIV in Part Two of this book), Adi Da comments on the unique and decisive significance of this date in global human history.

Throughout his life, Adi Da worked to develop literary and artistic means of conveying his communication to the world. Included in the book, between pages 276-277, is a work of art made by Adi Da in 2006 which bears the same title as the book: *Not-Two <u>Is</u> Peace*. In this Image, Adi Da makes a visually joyous communication about the prior unity of the entire "spectrum" of the human race.

The text in the image (a slightly varying version of a passage from this book, page 278) was hand-calligraphed by Adi Da:

"God"-ideas (and even <u>all</u> mere <u>ideas</u>) are ego-based "objectifications" (or Self-Reflected Self-Images) of the Intrinsic (and Inherently egoless) Self-Consciousness of Reality <u>Itself</u>—and, therefore, of Intrinsically Self-Evident (and Inherently egoless) Real Self (Itself).

No mere "God"-ideas Are Real (Acausal) God.

Only Reality <u>Itself</u> (and, therefore, Intrinsically Self-Evident and Inherently egoless Real Self, or Reality-Self, <u>Itself</u>) <u>Is</u> Real (Acausal) God.

Therefore, "God"-ideas (and even <u>all</u> mere <u>ideas</u>) must be (and, indeed, Always Already <u>are</u>) Transcended in, by Means of, and <u>As</u> Reality (Itself) and Real Self (Itself).

Real Self (or Reality-Self)—or the always first and always present Self-Condition of Conscious Awareness—<u>Is</u> Intrinsically Self-Evident <u>As</u> the Indivisible and Never-Broken Current of Feeling-Energy-Consciousness.

This *Not Two-<u>Is</u> Peace* Image was hung as a monumental banner at the "Religion after September 11" World Congress in Montreal (September 2006).

In the following year, ten works of image-art by Adi Da were shown at the 52nd Biennale di Venezia (2007), in the Collateral Exhibition Transcendental


